Christmas Drinks

Fruit Punch

2 cups Water

2 cups Sugar

1 cup Pineapple

1 cup Strawberries

1 cup Raspberries

1 cup Bananas

1 cup white Grapes

1 cup maraschino Cherries

Juice of 6 Oranges

Juice of 6 Lemons 8-10 bottles Soda Water

Boil the water and sugar for ten minutes. Cool and add other ingredients but crush the fruits before adding and reserve the soda water. Chill thoroughly and add soda water before serving.

Tropicana Punch

1 small glass Brandy, 1 small glass Curacao, 1 slice Orange

5 thin slices Pineapple, 6-8 Maraschino Cherries, 5 cups Claret,

3-4 teaspoons Sugar, 5 cups Lemonade or Soda Water, Dash of Maraschino, juice of 1 lemon

Mix together in a large bowl with plenty of ice.

Champagne Cocktail

Place a sugar loaf in each glass. On the sugar pour ½ teaspoon Brandy and a dash of bitters. Let stand for at least 10 minutes. Fill with icy cold Champagne.

Ruby Punch

3/4 cup Water

3/4 cup Sugar

6 sticks Cinnamon

1 teaspoon whole Cloves

2 cups chilled Burgundy

5 cups Apple Juice chilled.

Place Water, Sugar, Cinnamon and cloves in a saucepan and bring to the boil. Simmer mixture on low heat for about 10 minutes. Strain and chill – add the Wine and Apple Juice and serve chilled.

In Your Garden

Hello Village gardeners.

Summer is here again, it's time to prepare your garden for the hot months ahead. If you have not yet mulched it's your last chance to do so. Try applying a wetting agent first before you mulch to help keep the moisture in.

If you fed your lawn in spring it may be looking for a little extra feeding this time of the year to strengthen its roots to take up all the nutrients to stay green through the heat, organic fertilisers such as dynamic lifter are the best to use this time of the year as they don't require much water to release these important nutrients. Try to raise your cut on the mower as if you take too much off your lawn through the heat it will yellow off and the weeds will take over

In your vege patch, keep an eye on your veges as the bugs are all active at this time of the year and as the humid weather comes be careful you don't water too much of the foliage on your tomatoes, cucumbers and pumpkins as all are prone to fungal diseases such as powdery mildew and rust - keeping plants watered in the early hours of the day or later in the evenings will help stop this occurring.
