BLACK SUMMER BUSHFIRE RECOVERY GRANT

Balmoral Village Association has been successful!

Our grant submission was successful for a grand total of \$215,779 which will be broken into three financial years.

2021/22 \$43,156
2022/23 \$151,045
2023/24 21,578

We are excited to start work on these projects in the near future:

- ❖ Replace hall doors with fire doors.
- ❖ Add a covered awning to the front entrance of the hall.
- ❖ Install a new solar power system and battery.
- ❖ Upgrade current electricity system.
- ❖ Install fitness equipment on the western side of the tennis court.
- ❖ Refurbish the Tennis Clubhouse.
- ❖ Purchase rechargeable maintenance equipment and shed. This includes ride on mower, push mower, whipper snipper and blower.
- ❖ Install a security system over the hall and tennis facilities.

With the upgrade of the solar battery, the hall will be solar powered and able to work off the grid. This will help make the facility available to the community and/or the appropriate authorities in an emergency.

Our village Tennis Court continues to remain free of charge at this time.
